

AIUB's EEE Program Earns BAC Accreditation in Its First SAR Submission and Academic Audit

AIUB has reached a historic milestone in Bangladesh's higher education as its Bachelor of Science in Electrical and Electronic Engineering (EEE) Program has been officially accredited by the Bangladesh Accreditation Council (BAC). AIUB became the first university in the country to submit the Self-Assessment Report for the EEE Program on 21 May 2024 and to host BAC's inaugural Academic Audit Visit from 21–23 January 2025. This marks the first program in Bangladesh to receive BAC accreditation, the National Accreditation Authority.

The recognition followed a rigorous evaluation process, including self-assessment, external peer review, and on-site evaluation, ensuring compliance with national and international quality standards.

The accreditation confirms that AIUB's EEE program meets benchmarks in curriculum design, teaching–learning, assessment, faculty competence, infrastructure, governance, and continuous quality improvement, reflecting AIUB's commitment to academic excellence and outcome-based education.
