Seminar on “Developing Research Skills and the Role of Primary Health Care in Global Health” Held at AIUB

Friday, August 1, 2025

On 1 August 2025, the Department of Public Health, AIUB, organized a seminar on “Developing Research Skills and the Role of Primary Health Care in Global Health,” highlighting the significance of public health research and Primary Health Care (PHC). The keynote speaker, Dr. Mostafizur Rahman, PhD, Senior Manager at the National Health Service (NHS), UK, emphasized PHC as the backbone of global health systems. Dr. Rakia Ishra, Assistant Professor, Department of Public Health, AIUB, served as the first speaker.

The seminar was led by Dr. Muhammad Wasiful Alam, Head, Department of Public Health, with support from the departmental team. Distinguished attendees included Prof. Dr. Saiful Islam, Vice Chancellor; Prof. Dr. Md. Abdur Rahman, Pro Vice Chancellor; Prof. Dr. Tazul Islam, Dean, FASS; and other faculty. The event concluded with a thank-you note and a campus tour.

AIUB's MPH Students Shine at Leading Academic Conferences

Saturday, August 9, 2025

Two Master of Public Health (MPH) students from AIUB's Department of Public Health presented papers at leading conferences in August 2025.

On 9 August, Dr. Maryam Sharifi, a foreign student, presented at the Bangladesh Quality Improvement Convention at Hotel Intercontinental, Dhaka. Her paper, "An Analysis of Effective Quality Communication of Healthcare Professionals in Bangladesh as it Relates to Best Practices in the USA", co-authored with Dr. Muhammad Wasif Alam, Head of the Department, stressed integrating communication training in medical education, fostering egalitarian doctor-patient relationships, and adopting standardized protocols with safeguards (e.g., informed consent, HIPAA).

On 7 August in Bangkok, Dr. Asma Ferdowsi presented at the 11th International Conference on Public Health (ICOPH). Her research on physicians' adherence to guidelines in managing hypertension and diabetes highlighted gaps impacting outcomes.

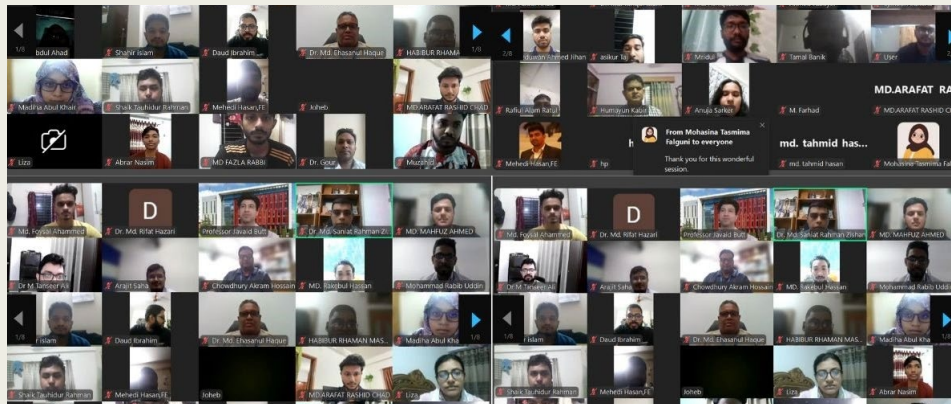
