Under the theme “Mind the Gap – It’s Getting Wider,” the conference brought together global leaders and innovators in higher education. Key highlights

Prof. Dr. Md. Saniat Rahman Zishan, Director, Faculty of Engineering; Dr. Chowdhury Akram Hossain, Associate Professor and Head, Department of CoE; and Mr. Mahamudul Hassan, Assistant Professor, Department of IPE, represented AIUB at STEAMhouse, Birmingham City University (BCU), UK.

Sunday, December 7, 2025


