Professional Education:

Professional Education includes 13 types of institutions. These are Medical University, Medical College, Armed Forces & Army Medical College, Dental College & Dental Unit, Nursing and Midwifery College & Institution, Homeopathic College, Unani/Ayurvedic, Textile Technology, Leather Technology, Law and Art Colleges, Agriculture College, and Library Science in 2021, there were 821 professional institutions in the country. This subsector has been growing. In 2000 total institutions were only 187. This number increased to 821 in 2021 (Table:6.2).

Among 821 institutions 15.71% were public and 84.29% were private. The rate of growth has seen higher in private professional institutions. The total students in 13 types of institutions were 191409 in 2021 and 51789 in 2003, showing a continuous growth in the past. **Among all students 62.72% were girls in 2021.** The gender parity index was 1.68. The number of students per institution was 233 in 2021, this number was 335 in public and 214 in private institutions. Among all students, the percentage of students in medical college was 26.21%, 3.75% in Dental College 23.59% in Homeopathic College, 3.84% in Law college, 31.63% in Nursing College and 10.98% in other 8 types of institutions.

Systematic Tracking of Female Applicants and Entrants

American International University–Bangladesh (AIUB) systematically monitors women's participation across its admissions process. The university maintains a statistical tracking system dedicated to female students, measuring the percentage of women who apply for admission, the percentage who are accepted, and the percentage who ultimately enroll. This data is collected each semester as part of AIUB's regular admissions cycle, providing a clear picture of how female applicants progress from application to entry. By analyzing female application and entry rates, AIUB gauges how many women successfully transition into its programs — a key measure of gender inclusivity in the admission system. These practices demonstrate that AIUB, as an institution, actively tracks women's application and acceptance rates as a part of its commitment to inclusive education.

AIUB Admission Process and Women's Application Tracking

1. AIUB Admission Process and Women's Application Tracking

At the American International University–Bangladesh (AIUB), admissions are conducted three times a year–Spring, Summer, and Fall. For each semester, AIUB issues an open and transparent admission call through its official online platform, inviting applications from all eligible students regardless of gender. From the pool of submitted applications, the university systematically tracks and measures the proportion of female applicants, providing an essential indicator of women's access at the initial stage of entry.

2. Admission Result and Tracking Women's Acceptance and Entry Rates

Following the admission test and evaluation process, AIUB publishes the list of qualified candidates online in a transparent manner. The institution then analyzes both the preliminary and final admission outcomes to determine the acceptance and entry rates of women. These data points reflect how many female applicants successfully transition from application to enrollment, serving as a key measure of gender inclusivity within the admission system.

3. Tracking Women's Continuation through Scholarship Data

Beyond entry-level access, AIUB further monitors women's participation through its online scholarship announcements. By analyzing the gender distribution among scholarship recipients, the university can assess the proportion of female students who continue their studies with institutional support, indicating women's sustained engagement and academic progression.

Equal Admission Criteria and Non-Discriminatory Policies

AIUB applies the **same admission criteria and conditions** to all applicants, regardless of gender. The university's official policy explicitly states that it "admits qualified and selected students of any age, gender, ... and national or ethnic origin" and "does not discriminate on the basis of ... gender" in its educational or admissions policies aiub.edu. Admission procedures (including eligibility criteria, application mechanisms, and entrance exams/fees) are transparent and outlined on AIUB's website and admission booklets for all prospective students. These materials confirm that women and men face identical requirements and processes for entry, with no gender-based differences in criteria or fees. AIUB's open admission calls invite applications from all eligible students without gender bias, and the institution's non-discriminatory admission policy ensures equal opportunity for both genders at every stage aiub.edu aiub.edu. All available information – from entry requirements to fee structures and completion statistics – is published without any distinction by gender, reflecting AIUB's commitment to fairness and inclusivity in higher education.
